Treasurer's Report: John Mitchell reported a balance of \$1,190.33 in the Friends' checking account.

Virginia Archaeology Month: Jackie Pamerter requested and received co-sponsorship of Virginia Archaeology Month in October 2009. The theme is Seeds to a Nation. There will be an exhibit at the library during October of artifacts discovered at the North Kitchen site at James Madison's Montpelier. A lecture will be held at the library on Monday, October 19, at 7 pm entitled "Presidential Archaeology: Jefferson and Madison, With a Twist" by Rick Britton.

Giving Tree: Sharon Lumadue and Cindy Dingledine agreed to once again coordinate a Giving Tree program similar to last year for approximately 50 students. The tree will be installed in the library on approximately November 6.

Film Movement: A decision was made to cancel the Film Movement series due to the lack of enthusiasm for the depressing subject matter of many of the films and decreased attendance. Films will be selected from the PBS POV series for programs through the end of 2009.

Membership: The next meeting is the annual membership meeting. It will be scheduled in November. The need for a Membership Chair and a new Treasurer was discussed.
