September 8, 2010
Board of Directors Meeting

The meeting convened at 7 PM. In attendance were Board Members Cindy Dingledine, Nancy Ford, Raina Morton, Mary Jo Sopelak, and Deborah Willenborg and Greene Library Branch Manager Ginny Reese.

Treasurer's Report: Deborah Willenborg reported information provided by Jennifer Linaberry – there is a balance of \$617.42 in the Friends checking account. The purchase of an end panel for the new Hold shelving was authorized if the cost would be less than or equal to \$200.

Membership and Publicity: November 10, 2010, 7 PM, is designated as the Annual Membership Meeting. However, all library Friends meetings are open to the public and all members are welcome to be involved and contribute to the organization. Deborah committed to designing a membership flyer. Raina committed to designing a bookmark to raise awareness of the Friends Facebook page; these bookmarks will be distributed in the library and at Friends sponsored events.

Giving Tree: The Giving Tree has been a tremendous success each of the past three years. Plans were made to put up the 2010 tree after Halloween. This year, in addition to the traditional "hand" tags identifying books for children, there will be a different-shaped set of tags identifying Friends of the Greene County Library programs. Ginny committed to developing the new tags. Cindy and Sharon Lumadue will once again coordinate the Giving Tree program, including two parties for the children in December.

Archaeology Month: A program cosponsored with the Greene County Historical Society is planned for Saturday, October 9, 2010, at 3 PM. The theme of this year's program is "Exploring Virginia's Historic Cemeteries." The speaker will be Franklin A. Robinson, Jr. and the title of his presentation is "Preserving Your Family Papers." Cindy will make an announcement at the program to raise awareness of the library Friends organization, pending Deb receiving permission from Jackie Pamerter of the Historical Society.

Festival of the Book: The Festival will be held March 16-20, 2011. The program at the Greene County Library will be on Saturday, March 19, 2011, at 4 PM. An author has not been scheduled at this point.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 10, 2010, at 7 PM.
