


Transferring to Devices

<p>To download audiobooks to listen to on your computer or a device, you'll need to download the OverDrive Media Console. Again, there is a link on the Quick Start guide, or you can go straight to this link:</p> <p>http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/</p>	<p>You will need to download Adobe Digital Editions to your computer. Transferring an eBook with Adobe Digital Editions

To transfer a title, make sure you're in Library View instead of Reading View. You can switch between the two using the small square icons in the top left corner. In the left sidebar, you'll see a list of bookshelves including All Items, Borrowed, Purchased, etc. When you connect your e-reader to your computer using the USB cable, a new bookshelf should appear with the name of the device. To transfer the title, simply click and drag the title from the list on the right and "drop" it onto the device on the left. Once you disconnect the device, the title will have been transferred!

Transferring to a Kindle with Amazon

Find and check out a title. Click **Get for Kindle** and the Amazon website will open in a new window. On the right side, click the yellow button that says **Get Library Book**. Log in to your Amazon account. Select the Kindle you wish to download to and click **Continue**.

If possible, Amazon will send the book to your Kindle wirelessly. If not, Amazon will display a message that it could not send the book instantly. Then you will need to download the book to your computer and manually transfer it. First, connect the Kindle to your computer using the USB cable. Find the file on your computer (possibly in your "My Downloads" folder). Right click and select "**Cut**." Now go to **My Computer** and find your Kindle. Double click and then open the **Documents** folder of your Kindle. Right click in the folder and select "**Paste**." This will transfer the title to your Kindle.

Kindle Fire

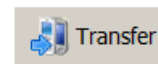
You should be able to follow the usual steps using your Kindle Fire web browser instead of a separate computer. You may also need to tap "Sync" for the title to show up in your Books.

TIP: How to Drag and Drop

To drag an item from one place to another, left-click as normal but keep the mouse button pressed down. You can then "drag" the file around on screen. When you want to "drop" the item in a new location, simply release your finger from the mouse.

Transferring Audiobooks to an iPod or MP3 Player with OverDrive Media Console

Once you have opened a title in the OverDrive Media Console, you'll see the book on the main screen. Click once to select the title – it should be highlighted blue. At the top of the screen, click **Transfer**.



If you have not already connected your device to your computer, it will prompt you to do so now. At this point, the Transfer Wizard window will show up. This will walk you through transferring your title to a device – make sure the correct device is selected then keep clicking “**Next**” to proceed.


You might notice that it will show you all of the chapters of the title in a list with small checkmarks beside them. Unless you only want to transfer part of a book, leave all of these checked.

Checking Out Titles with Your iPad or iPhone

To download eBooks OR audiobooks to your iPad, no transferring is required. You will, however, need an **Adobe ID** first to read any eBooks. Remember, you can get an Adobe ID here: <https://www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm> After you have your Adobe ID, you can use the OverDrive app to browse and check out titles.



Search for **OverDrive Media Console** in the Apple app store and download it to your iPad.

Once installed, tap  in the top right corner.



Tap the green plus sign next to **Add a Website** and search for JMRL by name, city, or zip code. Select any JMRL branch.

Once you sign in, you'll be able to browse, search, and check out books as normal. The first time you check out an eBook, it will ask you to authorize the iPad with the Adobe ID you created earlier.

The title will appear on the OverDrive app home screen. To listen or read, simply tap the title to begin!

Once titles have expired, the app will prompt you to delete them. To check in a title early, swipe your finger across the title until the red **Delete** button appears. Tap this button to see delete options, then tap **Return and Delete**.

Need to download the book again?

Once you have checked out a book, you can download the title to your computer anytime from the OverDrive website. Just sign in, go to **My Download Account**, then **My Items Out** and the download links will appear. If you have already downloaded the correct software, your computer will automatically want to open any titles you download in the right program.
