LANGUAGE HELP

To learn other languages or English as a Second Language (ESL) at the Jefferson-Madison Regional Library you can use the JMRL online catalog (<http://aries.jmrl.org/>) to:

- Find many books and CD's by using the Keyword search – examples: "Spanish language" or "English as a second language"
- Find **foreign films** by using the Keyword search – examples: "video recording and foreign film" or to find films from particular countries "video recording and foreign films and Germany"
- Find JMRL's small collection of works in other languages by using the Subject search – examples: "Spanish Language Materials, "French Language Materials," etc.
- Use JMRL's online language database BYKI: (go to **Databases** from the navigation bar on **jmrl.org** -- click on **Languages** in the left sidebar)
